
SMRBA Members Care

Here are Ways to Help You Make Your Email Better:

Do not type in all caps. That's yelling or reflects shouting emphasis.

Spell check – Emails with typos are simply not taken as seriously.

Use proper sentence structure.

Be sure the Subject Line accurately reflects the content of your email.
